Goals and Objectives

Musical Literacy

Apply the elements of music and musical techniques in order to sing and play music with accuracy and expression.

- Apply elemental changes, including changes to dynamics, tempo, timbre, or texture, when singing or playing music.
- Execute the performance of major scale tones using the voice.
- Apply the elements of music and musical techniques in order to sing and play music with accuracy and expression.

Interpret the sound and symbol systems of music.

- Interpret rhythm patterns, including notes and rests in 3/4 and 4/4 meter signatures.
- Interpret through voice and/or instruments visual representation of the major scale.
- Recognize standard symbols and traditional terms for dynamics, tempo, and articulation.

Create music using a variety of sound and notational sources.

- Use improvisation to create rhythmic and melodic ostinato accompaniments.
- Create soundscapes using a variety of sound sources.
- Create rhythmic compositions using whole, half, and quarter notes; half and quarter rests; and beamed eighth notes in duple or triple time.

Musical Response

Understand the interacting elements to respond to music and music performances.

- Illustrate the corresponding response to conductor gestures for meter, tempo, and dynamics.
- Use musical terminology when describing music that is presented aurally.
- Use established criteria to evaluate music.
- Identify the sounds of a variety of instruments and voices, including many orchestral instruments, instruments from various cultures, children's voices, and male and female adult voices.
